- ◆ **Entry & Delivery of Exhibits:**  
*All fleeces must be entered and delivered to Roberts Wool Store  
not later than Monday, 2 October 2017 – 9am*
- ◆ Judging Wednesday, 11 October 2017 at 9am
- ◆ Packages must bear the name and address of Exhibitor and be clearly marked "**Royal Hobart Show Entry**" and indicate the class entered.
- ◆ Presentation of Awards: Friday, 27 October 2017 at 4.00pm

#### **REGULATIONS**

- ◆ Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Rules & Regulations apply to all Sections of the Show & that the Special Regulations hereunder apply to this Section only & are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.
- ◆ All exhibitors are requested to include precise instructions as to the desired method of disposal at the conclusion of the Show. The Society will re-pack & re-address or deliver exhibits to any nominated authorised Wool Broker in Tasmania if so instructed, or re-address to place of origin. All costs & freight charges to be the responsibility of exhibitor. In this regard no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage in transit.
- ◆ No fleece will be accepted unless full freight has been prepaid. The judges will transfer any fleece to the class to which it rightfully belongs. Fleeces must be correctly skirted. Fleeces, which in the opinion of the judges are outside the industry standards, will be judged accordingly. All fleeces are to be shorn from sheep that are the bona fide property of the exhibitors. **All Fleeces must be grown in Tasmania in the preceding 12 months from the close of entries.** The Society accepts no responsibility for the loss or damage to any exhibit. The Council of the Society reserves the right: (a) To reject any entry or cancel any class. (b) To alter the conditions relating to any class.
- ◆ Judges should accept all test results except where a marked anomaly exists, then the Judges will adjudicate and adjust fleeces to their visual class.
- ◆ In addition to any special regulations herein all Exhibitors in this section are subject to the General Regulations for Competitors and Exhibitors of the Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania, copies of which are available on request from the Society.
- ◆ **Merino Ewe Fleece** – Winner eligible for entry into Grand Champion Merino Ewe Fleece of Tasmania. Entries must be grown in Tasmania and any entry from an exhibitor who Breed rams will be judged as a stud fleece.
- ◆ All fleeces with lambs tip must be entered into Class 10.

- “All Royal Hobart Show entrants are bound by all of the policies, procedures, rules and regulations of the Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania. These may be amended at the discretion of the Board and the Chief Executive officer of RAST.”

**GRAND CHAMPION FLEECE OF TASMANIA** – Value up to \$200 (donated by Worrall Lawyers), The Worrall Lawyers’ Perpetual Trophy, Sash and Certificate for the fleece selected by the judges as being the best fleece exhibited in the Fleece Competition.

**GRAND CHAMPION EWE FLEECE OF TASMANIA** – \$500 plus free insurance quote donated by MMIB Insurance Brokers and sash for the fleece judged as being the best merino ewe fleece grown in Tasmania.

**CHAMPION COMMERCIAL MERINO EWE FLEECE** - \$300 & Society’s Sash sponsored by RAMS Tasmania. Fleeces exhibited by owners who do not breed their own rams. Fleeces will be drawn from all applicable sections plus individual entries.

**Note:** An individual Fleece will only be eligible for one Grand Championship Award.  
All Grand Champions will only be eligible to exhibitors who are 18 years of age and over.  
Any entry from an exhibitor who breed Rams will be judged as a Stud fleece

- Class 5 Medium Merino ram fleece 19.6 to 21u
- Class 6 Medium Merino ewe or wether fleece 19.6 to 21u
- Class 7 Strong Merino ram fleece 21.1 and broader
- Class 8 Strong Merino ewe or wether fleece 21.1 and broader
- Class 9 Best dual purpose Merino/Dohne/Sam cross ewe or wether fleece
- Class 10 Most even group of 3 Merino ewes or wethers with a lambs tip (open) fine, medium, strong. Entry fee: \$15.00
- Class 11 Best Group of three Merino fleeces (open). Entry fee \$15.00
- Class 12 Merino Ewe Fleece. Entry for fleeces not entered in any other class Owners from winning ewe fleece competitions from other Tasmanian shows over the last 12 months are eligible to enter a fleece.
- Class 13 Polwarth ram fleece
- Class 14 Polwarth ewe or wether fleece
- Class 15 Corriedale ram fleece
- Class 16 Corriedale ewe or wether fleece
- Class 17 Group of three Corriedale fleeces. Ewes or Wethers. Entry fee \$15.00
- Class 18 Border Leicester fleece - ewe or wether
- Class 19 English Leicester fleece - ewe or wether
- Class 20 Other - Traditional British Breed Fleece - ewe or wether fleece. Judged by individual breed
- Class 21 Fleece entered by an exhibitor under the age of 18 years. Age to be as at 1 October 2017. Fleece may be of any breed. ENTRY FEE \$5.00 1st Place \$25, 2nd Place \$15, 3rd Place \$10
- Class 22 Registered Wool Classer only - must have a classed fleece entered in the Show
