The Regatta Grounds become the Showground

The Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania is thrilled to be bringing the 2022 PETstock Royal Hobart Show back into the City of Hobart – where the Show was first held in 1822

The Show is one of the biggest annual events in Tasmania, and its home - the Showground at Glenorchy - is about to be transformed into an ultra-modern event, living and recreational space.

Building work is planned to commence next year, and planning on holding the Royal Hobart Show back at the new Showground, with a brand-new arena and supporting pavilion, in 2025.

The Society has owned the Showground in Glenorchy since 1903 when it purchased 40 acres of bushland then known as Elwick Knoll. In subsequent decades, hundreds of thousands of show goers have become familiar with the Showground which has changed little over that time.

Our thanks to City of Hobart for its embrace of the Show back in the city, and we're looking forward to a wonderful new experience based on the Regatta Grounds and Hobart City Hall.

The much needed re-imagination of the Showground will ensure the Show continues as Australia's oldest agricultural show for the next 200 years, and you will be amazed by what you see when you come to your first Show at the Showground in 2025.




THE ROYAL HOBART SHOW Site Plan

They will play host to a broad range of animals including alpacas, goats, cavies (guinea pigs), bees, a miniature horse and a host of other surprises. The Life on the Farm display is an educational centre designed to introduce city folk to the role of agricultural animals. Demonstrations include sheep shearing, bee keeping, chook washing, butter making and lots of free hands-on activities for young people such as grinding grain, digging spuds and planting tomato or carrot seeds.

ARTERY ART ON SHOW

(CITY HALL)

This is one of the biggest annual art exhibitions in Tasmania, open to amateurs and professionals alike. The Royal Hobart 'Artery Art on Show' attracts more than 200 entries each year. The art reflects the creative skills of the Tasmanian community. A wide range of traditional and abstract styles will be on display covering works in oil, acrylic, water colour, mixed media and pastel. Prize money of more than \$10,000 is awarded thanks to the generosity of Artery.

DOG JUDGING

(REGATTA GROUNDS)

Dog judging starts 9.30am Wednesday and continues on every day of the Show. Over 400 dogs, covering 109 different breeds from all over Australia are competing for the coveted title of "Best Dog in Show" at the Regatta Grounds. This is a major event in the canine calendar and is brought to you by Royal Canin. This year, the Show hosts renowned Italian judge, Claudio de Giuliani. Claudio has judged at many prestigious dog shows, including Crufts. Judging this year covers breeds ranging from Affenpinscher, Griffon Bruxellois, and Pugs, to Chesapeake Bay Retrievers, Sussex Spaniels, and Wirehead Slovakian Pointers, King Charles, now there's a name in the news at the moment, may join us: King Charles spaniels, that is,

FOUR ROSES CREATIVE CRAFTS

(CITY HALL)

One of the traditions of the Royal Hobart Show is the Creative Crafts Section. It aims to recognise people in our community who are doing great creative things: from culinary arts to jewellery making, knitting, crochet, embroidery, recycling and repurposing, and much more. This section continues to evolve to reflect community trends. For instance, only recently a Wearable Art Competition was introduced.

FRIDAY NIGHT ENTERTAINMENT

(REGATTA GROUNDS FROM 5.00PM FRIDAY NIGHT)

Friday Night at the Show has been a family tradition for many years and this year's program is sure to have something for everyone. All the Show's entertainment offerings will be performing, and the night ends with a massive fireworks display over the city. The night will be kicking off

with a big performance from local Tasmanian band Night Shift and will conclude with a major fireworks display with Hobart's eastern shore in the background. Friday night really is the ideal time to visit the Show!

RAST EXHIBITION - 200 YEARS OF AGRICULTURAL SHOWING

(REGATTA GROUNDS IN THE GRANDSTAND)

The formation of a Van Diemen's Land Agricultural Society, now the RAST, was proposed at a meeting of interested land and stockholders at the Ship Inn, now the Central Hotel, in Collins St, Hobart on December 3, 1821. They had a number of concerns including a wish to establish a cattle show in Hobart Town.

In 2022, RAST celebrated 200 Years of Showing and we will be bringing our historical display to the Regatta Grounds event for this year's Show. This is a great interactive display of one of our great industries, educational, informative, and highly entertaining.

REPTILE RESCUE

(REGATTA GROUNDS)

Snakes and lizards galore! One of our most popular exhibits is back again this year. Learn about handling snakes; find out which ones are venomous, and get a close up look if you dare. Educational talks and demonstrations will occur throughout each day so check our program for exact times.

TASMANIAN GOVERNMENT PAVILION

(REGATTA GROUNDS)

The Tasmanian Government returns with an interactive display covering primary industries, emergency services, health and many other areas. The tent is jam packed with

kid's activities including a Police motorbike to sit on and a large red dinosaur ready to take a selfie with vou.

VINTAGE CARS

(REGATTA GROUNDS)

Always a favourite these old time cars will this year be located next to the Vintage Machinery display and are always a must visit at the Show for everyone to be able to see and reminisce over cars from vestervear.

VINTAGE MACHINERY AND **TRANSPORT**

(REGATTA GROUNDS)

Always one of the most visited exhibits at the PETstock Royal Hobart Show, the Vintage (Heritage) Machinery and Transport areas present more than 100 individual items of vintage machinery.

WOODCHOPPING

(REGATTA GROUNDS)

Entries are up this year as we recover from Covid lockdowns, and it doesn't get more Australian than this with nearly 400 entries this year. There will be a full program of activities over three days from Thursday including men's, women's and team events. Located at the southern end of the Regatta Grandstand.

YOUTH ART & STUDENT PHOTOGRAPHY

(CITY HALL)

A new home at City Hall, more space and better combination of youth art and student photography. A major feature of the Show this year will be our Black & White Photography competition. This is an extremely popular competition and is a must enter for any student looking to show their photos for the first time. Check out the Youth Art & Student Photography section for further details.

7HOFM LIVE BROADCAST!

Thursday and Friday at the Regatta Grounds, Saturday at City Hall 7HOFM will this year be live broadcasting from our city locations throughout the event. Come and see what it takes to live broadcast on the Show's favourite radio station. Keep an eye out throughout the Show for the chance to meet Sarah, Mick and Johnno.

AROUND AND ABOUT

As we've mentioned, some Show activities this year are being held around and about the central Show hubs of the Regatta Grounds and the Hobart City Hall. This is because of the pending redevelopment of the Hobart Showground. The Show's Poultry and Cavies (Guinea Pigs) Judging occurred in July at the Showground with huge entry numbers! Here is a schedule of other Show activities around and about

ALPACAS

(29/30 OCTOBER AT **HOBART SHOWGROUND)**

Tasmania is an acknowledged centre of Alpaca breeding and rearing. Alpacas are social herd animals and should always be kept with others of their kind, or at the very least with other herd animals. Gentle, elegant, inquisitive, intelligent and observant, they are cautious and nervous if they feel threatened. A number of alpaca fleeces are displayed at this year's Royal Hobart Alpaca Show. Alpacas are shorn once a year, usually in spring. Fleece weights range from 2-5kg and are valued according to their micron and silky feel.

BEEF CATTLE

(20/21 OCTOBER AT HOBART SHOWGROUND)

Cattle first came to Australia with the First Fleet in 1788. They did poorly in the tough Australian conditions so different breeds from Europe, including Shorthorn and Hereford. were transported to Australia to improve quality. A Junior Beef Cattle Handling competition will take place on Friday morning. In the afternoon on Friday the Junior Beef Cattle judging will be at 1pm. The always popular Cattle Fancy dress will be held on Friday afternoon.

FLEECE

(29 OCTOBER AT CAMPBELL TOWN SHOWGROUND)

The Fleece competition is a showcase of wool from all parts of Tasmania. Feel the different types of wool and find out what makes a good fleece. The best fleeces in Tasmania will be on display including the Supreme Champion Fleeces.

GOATS

(29 OCTOBER AT CAMPBELL TOWN SHOWGROUND)

RAST is very proud to be taking the Goats judging to the beautiful Campbell Town Showground this year: a great venue for the animals while we await the redevelopment of the Hobart Showground. Goat breeds can be classified into three different types, meat, dairy and fibre. Dairy breeds include Anglo-Nubian, British Alpine, Saanen and Toggenburg, Fibre breeds are Angora and Cashmere, while Boer is a meat breed.

There is no charge to the public for visiting the goat judging.

HORSE COMPETITIONS

(20, 22 AND 23 OCTOBER AT **COAL VALLEY EQUESTRIAN** CENTRE)

More than 350 horses and ponies will compete at the Royal Hobart Show. There are many different breeds of horse taking part as they compete for the sought after Blue Ribbon. You can visit the Pony Club competition on 20 October and then visit Equestrian competition on 22 and 23 October at Coal Valley Equestrian Centre. Entry into the venue is free for the public to visit.

SHEEP

(29 OCTOBER: CAMPBELL TOWN SHOWGROUND)

One of Australia's great rural assets, sheep judging will be held at the Campbell Town Showground on 29 October. After that, it's time for them to go back to pasture. Sheep are an extremely valuable part of Australia's agricultural industry. The Royal Hobart Show presents many different breeds of sheep, most bred for a specific purpose (either wool or

ATM FACILITIES AT THE REGATTA GROUNDS

This year you will find an ATM located next to the Main Gate.

Toilet Facilities

There are numerous toilet facilities located around the Regatta Grounds and at City Hall. Please refer to the map for specific locations at the Regatta Grounds or see our volunteers at City Hall for directions.

FIRST AID

You will find the St Johns First Aid Marquee next to the Main Grandstand. In case of an emergency contact Show staff, Security or Police.

LOST PERSONS CENTRE

If you find a child, or your child becomes lost, please bring them direct to the Show Office located under the Main Grandstand or speak to a member of Show Staff or Security who will be able to help you.

LOST PROPERTY - TAKE TO ADMIN

If you find any lost property, please hand this into the Show Office located under the Main Grandstand or hand to a member of security.

WHAT TO BRING

GETTING TO THE SHOW

Metro: Check the online Metro timetables for regular services to the Regatta Grounds, City Hall or the Hobart Showground Parking arrangements: Limited parking is available on site with access available off McVilly Drive and then by moving under the Bridge of Remembrance into the carpark. Parking is \$10 and is open to all Showgoers, no matter the location you are visiting.

Disabled Parking: Limited Disabled Parking is located in the carpark off McVilly Drive next to the Main Gate. You will find the location for this on the Show Map.

Bicycles: Bring a security device to secure your bike and park it in the car park off McVilly Drive next to the disability parking area.

Scooters: This year the PETstock Royal Hobart Show have partnered with Neuron Scooters! You will find an abundance of Scooters near the entries to the Regatta Grounds and City Hall. Please jump on a scooter and travel between the locations but remember to Scoot Safe!

ANIMALS ON DISPLAY

If you are visiting the animal judging, please be aware that some breeds of animals are not at the Show the whole time. Although many animals are domesticated, they can cause injury and should be treated with caution. The size and bulk of some animals can make them potentially very dangerous.

- Avoid quick movements or loud noises that may frighten the animals.
- Do not poke, tease or imitate the sound the animal makes.
- Beware of standing behind the animals, as livestock can kick forward, sideways and backwards.
- Only pat the animals if the owner is present and gives his or her permission. Wash hands afterwards.

- Move slowly in single file around livestock.
- Allow enough space between you and the animals to avoid being stepped on or kicked.
- Most animals tend to be aggressive when protecting their young. Be extra careful around newborn animals.
- Touch animals gently and don't push or shove, but only when allowed to do so.
- Always wash your hands after touching animals. Facilities are located at the entry and exit points of animal pavilions.

FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE

For the safety of all animals, across all locations, if you have recently travelled overseas, please ensure you wear footwear and clothing which has been well cleaned prior to coming to the PETstock Royal Hobart Show.
